

JLMUN 2026 – Code of Conduct

Welcome to JLMUN 2026. As participants, you are expected to uphold the highest standards of professionalism, diplomacy, and respect throughout the conference. Since our venue is the Notre Dame Hotel, all delegates, chairs, and staff must ensure that their behavior reflects positively on both JLMUN and their respective institutions.

General Conduct & Professionalism

All participants must:

- Treat fellow delegates, chairs, staff, JLMUN team and hotel personnel with respect at all times.
- Use diplomatic and appropriate language in all settings, both inside and outside committee rooms.
- English is the official language of the conference .
- Avoid any form of harassment, discrimination, or disruptive behavior.
- Follow instructions from the Secretariat, team , chairs, and hotel staff immediately and respectfully.
- Maintain a calm and professional atmosphere in all hotel areas, especially hallways, elevators, and common spaces.
- Refrain from any actions that may disturb hotel guests or disrupt the environment of Notre Dame Hotel.

Any behavior that damages the reputation of JLMUN or disturbs hotel operations may result in disciplinary action.

Hotel Conduct

As guests of Notre Dame Hotel, all participants are expected to:

- Respect hotel property, furniture, and facilities.
- Stay only in designated conference and accommodation areas.
- Avoid entering restricted or guest-only zones.
- Maintain silence and order in corridors, especially during evening and early morning hours.
- Not engage in loud conversations, running, or gatherings that may disturb other guests.
- Follow all safety and security instructions issued by hotel staff at all times.

Any damage caused to hotel property will be the responsibility of the individual delegate and/or their school.

Dress Code : Formal Business Attire

Required Attire:

- Formal suits, blazers, and formal trousers or skirts
- Formal dresses (knee-length)
- Formal shoes

Not Allowed:

- Jeans, shorts, or casual trousers
- T-shirts, hoodies, or sweatshirts
- Sneakers or informal footwear
- Revealing or inappropriate clothing
- Clothing with large prints, logos, or slogans

Electronic Devices Policy

The use of electronic devices (phones, laptops, tablets) is permitted during the conference for academic and MUN-related purposes only, such as:

- Research
- Resolution writing
- Communication with delegates for committee work

However:

- Any unprofessional use of electronic devices (including but not limited to social media, gaming, watching unrelated content, or excessive personal messaging) is strictly prohibited during sessions.
- Chairs, Team and Secretariat members reserve the right to confiscate devices temporarily if they are misused or disrupt committee proceedings.
- Repeated misuse may result in further disciplinary action.

Opening & Closing Ceremonies

All participants are expected to maintain complete decorum during official ceremonies.

Delegates must:

- Be seated properly at all times.
- Remain silent during speeches and performances.
- Avoid talking, whispering, or any form of disturbance.
- Refrain from using phones or any electronic devices unless explicitly permitted.

Any disruption during ceremonies will be taken seriously and may affect awards eligibility.

Committee Etiquette

Delegates are expected to:

- Arrive on time to all sessions.
- Maintain formal conduct during speeches and debates.
- Speak only when recognized by the Chair.
- Avoid side conversations and interruptions.
- Use devices only when authorized for MUN work.
- Attendance will be taken at the start of each session.
- Late arrivals may face penalties at the discretion of the Chairs .
- Delegates must remain in their assigned committees unless permitted otherwise.

The use of Artificial Intelligence (AI)

Using Artificial Intelligence tools during JLMUN is permitted only as a supportive resource for research, preparation, and understanding of topics. Delegates may use AI to help them gather background information, clarify concepts, or improve the structure and language of their work. However, AI must not be used to generate entire speeches, draft resolutions without delegate input, or replace independent critical thinking and diplomatic engagement.

All submissions and contributions must reflect the delegate's own understanding, analysis, and effort. Misuse of AI, including plagiarism or over-reliance that undermines authentic participation, may result in penalties at the discretion of the Secretariat.

Consequences of Misconduct

Violations of this Code of Conduct may result in:

- Warnings
- Deduction of awards eligibility points
- Removal from committee sessions
- Expulsion from the conference
- Notification to school administration

Final Note

By participating in JLMUN 2026, all delegates agree to respect and follow the rules stated in this Code of Conduct in order to maintain a professional, respectful, and organized conference environment. The Secretariat trusts every participant will represent themselves, their schools, and the values of diplomacy in the best possible manner throughout the conference.
